1492 Columbus Sailed the Ocean Blue. Sent by Spain in search of the Indies. Found The Bahamas (San Salvador) instead. It took days of sailing on the Nina, the Pinta, and the Santa Maria. During 50 years of Columbus rule o Haiti, up to 8 million natives disappear.
1499 The Americas are named for Italian explorer, Amerigas
Other Explorers: 1271 Marco Polo explores 1579 Sir Francis Drake explores California. 1600 Ponce deLeon seeks the "Fountain of Youth." Magellen circumnavigates (sails around) the globe.
1000 Five hundred years before Columbus, the come to North America. (Other evidence suggests Irish Monks were the first to arrive in North America, around 500 AD)
1543 Bartolome Ferrelo claims Pacific Northwest, including Oregon, for Spain.
1500's Spanish explorers bring to America. Natives call them
1576 — European traders take 40,000 African men, women, and children from their homes and sell them into slavery.
1583-86 — Sir Walter attempts but fails to establish the first colony in the New World (at Roanoke).
