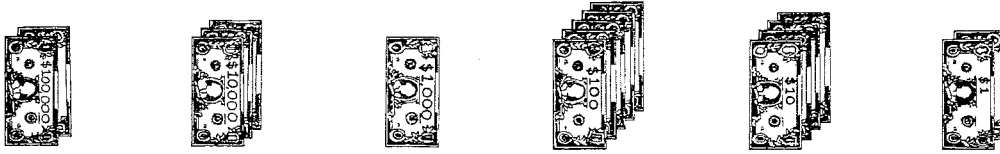


More About Thousands

Each group of 3 digits in a number is called a **period**. The ones' period and the thousands' period are the first two periods.



Thousands Period			Ones Period		
hundred thousands	ten thousands	thousands	hundreds	tens	ones
2	3	1	5	4	2

We say: "two hundred thirty-one thousand, five hundred forty-two"

We write: 231,542

We can write (in **expanded form**):

$$200,000 + 30,000 + 1,000 + 500 + 40 + 2$$
