In an effort to include community service as part of your child's fifth grade education, the students of Room 15 have elected to participate in the City of Central Point's Adopt-A-Street Program. We have pledged to keep Hopkins Road a safe and pleasant place by holding a litter pick-up at least four times per year. Our **second** pick-up is scheduled for **Friday, February 11th**. The City of Central Point will be providing safety vests, flashing warning signs, and trash bags.

We will be departing on foot at 12:45 and will return to the school by 2:15. Students need to wear sturdy shoes and clothing appropriate for the weather (rain or shine). Each student will be provided latex gloves, but if students wish to wear their own work gloves from home, that is fine.

At least 5 adult chaperones are needed for this event. If you're willing to participate, please indicate so on the form below. We'll be counting on you to lead and supervise a small group. We'll also need one volunteer with a vehicle to move the warning signs as we proceed.
